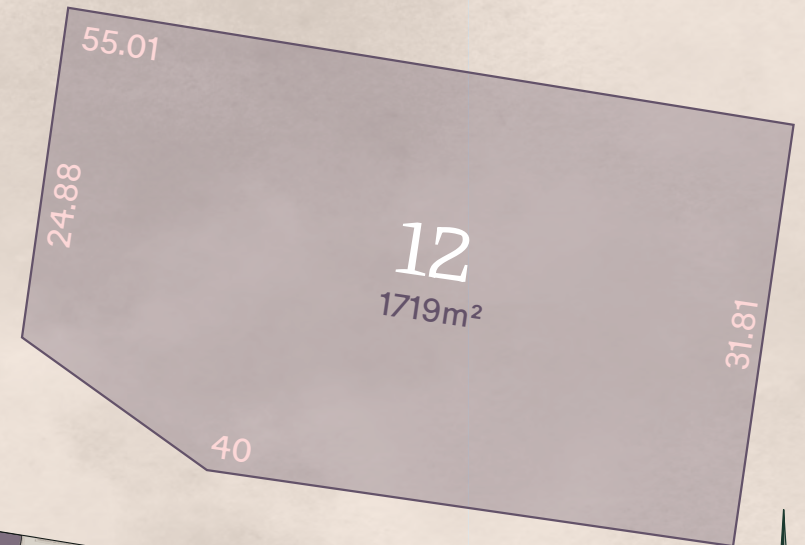


Lot 12 — Barrel Terrace

Reinlover Release — Lot 12



If you've spent any time in Beaconsfield, you'll know that blocks like this are becoming increasingly rare. At 1,719m², Lot 12 offers the kind of space that once drew families to the area in the first place. Backing onto natural vegetation, it feels tucked away from the world, with room for a substantial home, a pool, a shed, a caravan and all the things that tend to accumulate over a life well lived. 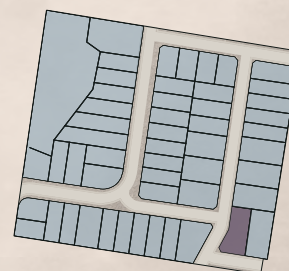


Lot 39 — Corner Fetlock Drive and Pastern Place

Lot 39 enjoys the kind of position people often wish they'd secured sooner. Set on a corner opposite the future reserve, it offers both flexibility and a lasting sense of openness. The established stone retaining gives the homesite an immediate sense of character, while the outlook creates a connection to the landscape that will continue to define the streetscape as Acre Ridge matures. It's a place that feels connected, considered and quietly confident in what it offers.





Lot 40 — Fetlock Drive

Positioned opposite a future reserve and alongside open land, Lot 40 enjoys a quiet sense of generosity. The outlook feels expansive, the rhythm of daily life a little less hurried. Here, children can grow up with reserve across the road, morning walks begin at your doorstep and the landscape remains part of the view. It is a homesite that balances simplicity with possibility, creating space for life to unfold naturally over time.



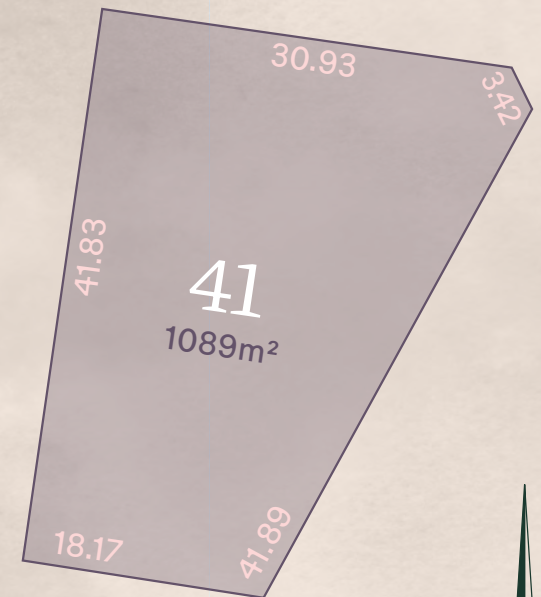


Lot 41 — Pastern Place

Bathed in northern sunlight and overlooking future reserve land, Lot 41 has been shaped around the things that matter most. Light filled living spaces, gardens that flourish, long lunches that spill outdoors and room to gather family and friends throughout the seasons. Its generous frontage and corner position provide flexibility in design, while the open outlook ensures a lasting connection to the landscape that defines Acre Ridge.



Masterplan

The Reinlover Release introduces a collection of homesites shaped by the landscape and open character of Acre Ridge. Positioned alongside future reserves, natural vegetation and expansive surrounds, each lot offers its own sense of space and connection to the land.

From generous corner allotments and wide frontages to desirable solar orientation and substantial build pads, these homesites have been carefully considered to balance practicality with place. The release is anchored by one of Acre Ridge's largest homesites, offering rare space, privacy and an outlook across natural vegetation.

Set within Beaconsfield's rolling surrounds, The Reinlover Release offers an opportunity to build with intention, creating a home that embraces space, nature and a community designed for the long term.
